

Located in Prouds Lane, Bilston. Exit the M6 at Junction 10 and follow the A454 Black Country Route to Bilston. Turn right onto the A41 and Prouds Lane is located on the edge of Bilston Town Centre. If approaching from Wolverhampton follow the A41 to the junction with Prouds Lane.
